The remains of **Andrew Gregory** of Co. E, 16<sup>th</sup> Regt., who died from the effects of wounds received in the recent battles on the Rappahannock, reached Plattsburgh Tuesday evening, May 26, and were interred yesterday afternoon with military honors. His late comrades in arms of the 16<sup>th</sup> Regiment, and the Sprague Cavalry, attended the funeral with muffled drums, and a salute was fired over his grave by a squad of the Cavalry regiment.
