

Ira M. Henry was a little older than the average private when he enlisted in 1862 - 33 years old. At the time, he was living in Schuyler Falls and working as a shoemaker.

After he was discharged as a sergeant from Balfour Hospital in Portsmouth, VA, on June 13, 1865, he tried his hand at farming for a while in Saranac. He also was a dealer in leather and shoemaker there. Later he returned to shoemaking at Schoolhouse Corners in Morrisonville. According to the newspapers, he ended up as a laborer doing odd jobs around town.

The 1898 Assessment Roll for Schuyler Falls shows him as owning house and land in Patent 6, Lot 60, 1 acre, value \$180 and he paid his taxes of \$5.40.

Ira died in 1903 and he and his wife, Abigail Allen, are buried in the Schuyler Falls Old Cemetery.
