

From the Essex County Republican - June 1907 - News of the death of Mr. **Henry J. Northrup** was received by Keeseville friends on Monday. Mr. Northrup was a resident of our village in his youth and had many warm friends here. He has recently been living in Detroit, MI, where his death occurred. He is survived by his wife, **Julia**, and son **Henry M. Northrup**. About three years ago Mr. Northrup was in Keeseville with his wife, renewing old acquaintances and associations and making pleasant new ones. He was a man of many genial and attractive qualities who will be deeply missed. His death was from Bright's disease.

J. Northrup enlisted as a private in

1862 at Ausable. When he mustered out, he was a first lieutenant and quartermaster.

After the Civil War he moved to Saginaw, MI. The 1870 US Census shows he was living in Michigan with his wife and baby son, Henry, who was born there.

On July 6, 1880, he was appointed Postmaster. In the City Directory of 1880, he was also listed as a lumberman and working for Wells, Stone and Co.
