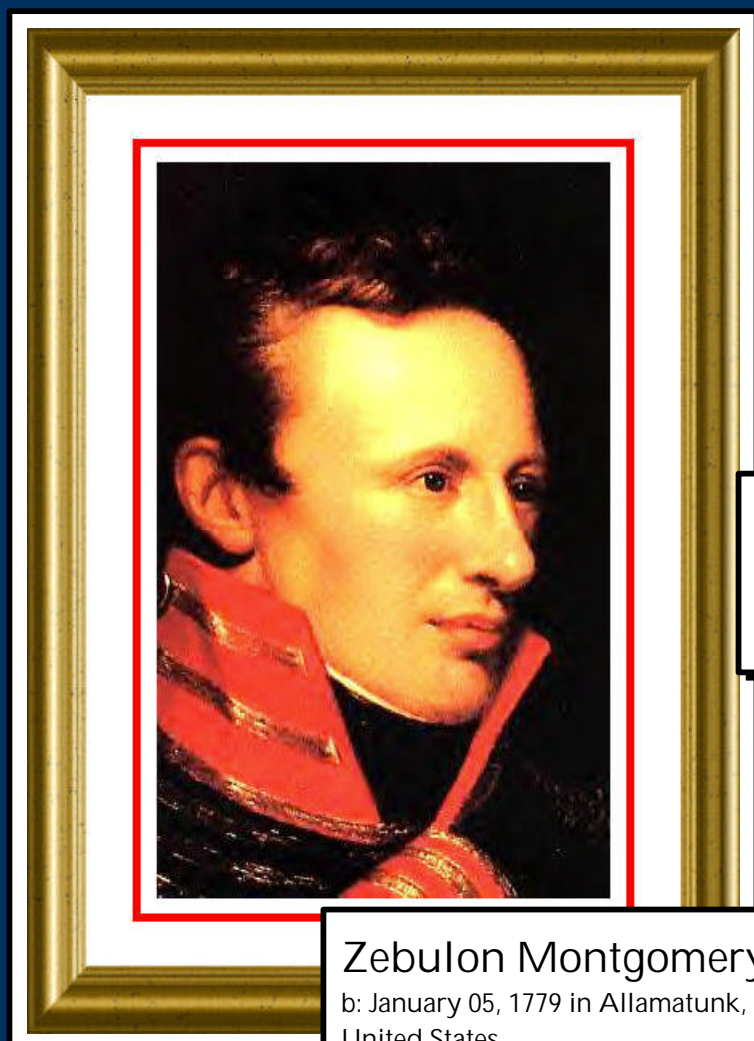


Ancestors of Clarissa Brown Pike, daughter of Brigadier General Zebulon Montgomery Pike (1779-1813)

Zebulon Pike eloped with his first cousin, Clarissa, Harlow Brown, to Cincinnati in 1801. He was an explorer after whom Pike's Peak, CO was named in 1806. He built Pike's Cantonment in Plattsburgh in 1812. He died in an explosion at Fort York in 1813.
